

### **Museum of King Jan III's Palace at Wilanów**

The Wilanów Palace is a baroque pearl of Warsaw. The palace and garden have remained unchanged despite partitions, wars and occupation. You will feel here like King Jan III Sobieski - a Turk conqueror from Vienna, who in 1683 stopped their march through Europe. The ruler, who gained the nickname of the fearless Lion of Lechistan in Europe, lived in it together with his beloved wife Marysieńka. We will visit Apartments Marszałkowa Lubomirska, Chinese Rooms, Hunter's Rooms, Warehouse Gallery.

### **Royal Garden of Lights**

The Royal Garden of Light at the Wilanów Palace is an outdoor exhibition, under which thousands of colorful LEDs are arranged in subtle shapes, creating beautiful illuminations. Visiting the Wilanów park after dark you will feel like at the royal court! A 75-meter luminous tunnel will lead you to the palace, where classical music resounds. In the courtyard, a lit pergola guarded by eagles will greet you, and in the northern garden you will be able to enter the alley planted with vines and see a 17th-century gazebo.

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
